Farragut is looking to defend back-to-back state titles and is a regular in the Baseball America/National High School Baseball Coaches Association Top 25. Columbus fell to No. 5 after taking its second loss of the season.

The weather is warming up around the country and only a few teams are left with no record. That means there is more movement as six teams hit some early bumps and dropped from the rankings. Sarasota High (FL) is highest ranked of the new teams. The Sailors checked in at No. 13 after beating then No. 7 Naples High (FL). Sarasota hosts its annual baseball tournament this week and 2010 marks the 25th anniversary of the event. No. 16 Archbishop McCarthy Southwest Ranches High (FL) is also in the tournament as well as American Heritage High Plantation (FL), the 2008 National Champions that are banging on the door of the 2010 rankings.
